Splitting the cost of the freezer was presented at the meeting and approved by a vote of the members present with the cavoite that our share not exceed \$500. Last year a veteran family couldn't be located and the funds were donated to a single parent family. This year the decision was made to try to locate a veteran family through another church if possible. As of this date I have not been able to do that. Partially because of the limited time frame and partially because of the busy schedule we all have this time of year.
