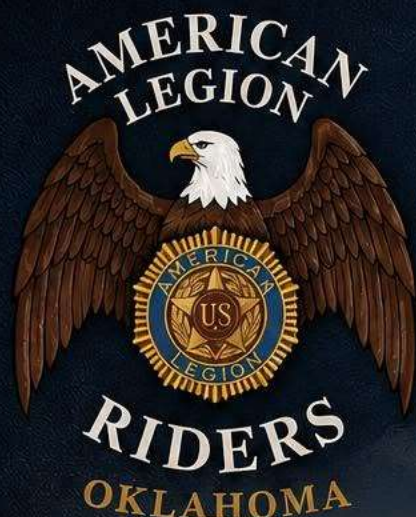
New Business
