

MINUTES OF MEETING

 - G. Discussed the fact that the Post needs to contact the Children's Home and the Veteran's Home to find out when we can visit and give them their gifts.
 - H. Discussed the contents of the gift bags for the children and veterans. By phone, Ms. Smith-Lattig advised she always prepares 68 bags for the veterans, 50 for men and 18 for women.
